

PRODUCTION COMPLETED ON PSYCHOLOGICAL THRILLER *WALLED IN*

WALLED IN, a feature film starring Mischa Barton (*The OC*, *Assassination of a High School President*), Deborah Kara Unger (*The Game*, *The Hurricane*) and Cameron Bright (*X Men 3*, *Thank You For Smoking*) wrapped production in Regina, Saskatchewan (Canada) on December 1, 2007.

The character-based psychological thriller started shooting in and around Regina, Saskatchewan, on October 22. The script is adapted from the best-selling French-language novel *Les Emmurés*, by Serge Brussolo, who is popularly referred to as the Stephen King of France.

Mischa Barton plays Sam, a demolition expert who encounters alarming circumstances when she travels to a remote location to supervise the demolition of a mysterious building. She soon discovers the horrifying secrets of the building and its past inhabitants, many of whom were victims of its famed architect who entombed his prey alive within the walls of the building. Mary (Deborah Kara Unger) is the building's caretaker whose son, Jimmy (Cameron Bright) leads Sam through the secrets of the building.

French director Gilles Paquet-Brenner made his English-language directing debut. He previously directed the French box-office hit *Gomez and Tavares* and the critically acclaimed *Les Jolies Choses*.

Paris-based production companies Experience Films and Forecast Pictures produced the project alongside Canada's Minds Eye Entertainment. The project is a Canada-France international treaty co-production, with financing and distribution assistance from Los Angeles and Berlin-based Leomax Entertainment.
